



### **TICKET HOLDER INFORMATION**

**ATTENTION Wine About Winter 2019 ticket holders!** We are so excited to welcome you to our 6th annual Wine About Winter wine tasting event on Friday, February 1<sup>st</sup>, from 5 - 9 PM in historic Downtown Salisbury, North Carolina. Please see below for some important information and reminders regarding this event.

This is a *rain or shine* event as all of the wine tastings occur inside the different participating shops and restaurants in Downtown Salisbury. **All ticket holders must come to Will Call on Friday, February 1<sup>st</sup> to have their ID's checked and to present their ticket to redeem their glass, souvenir wine bag, tasting pass, and wristband.**

Will Call will open at 4 PM on Friday, February 1<sup>st</sup> located in the lobby of the Visitors Center (204 E Innes St.). **Please enter through the back door.**

Tickets may not be picked-up before Friday at 4 PM. Will Call will be open the entire time during the event in case you do not arrive until later in the evening. You may not pick up tickets for anyone else. Each ticket holder must be present to show their ID before picking up items.

Parking is available behind the Visitors Center, on street, or in various other lots in the downtown area. For a map of available downtown parking [click here](#).

Upon arriving at the Visitors Center you will be asked to present a valid photo ID. Once it has been verified you are 21 years or older and given a wristband, you will proceed through the ticketing line. A volunteer will then scan your ticket and provide you with a glass, souvenir wine bag, and tasting pass. We will have other volunteers on hand ready to provide you with further information and answer any of your questions.

**Everyone must present a valid photo ID, no exceptions.**

Along with a valid photo ID, please bring with you to Will Call a copy of your purchased ticket. This may be a printed copy or in the form of a digital passbook. After your ID is checked, we will scan your ticket. If you cannot find your ticket, please contact us at (704) 637-7814 or email [latoya.price@salisburync.gov](mailto:latoya.price@salisburync.gov).

Complimentary trolley service will be provided throughout the evening in the downtown district for easy accessibility to all locations. The trolley will run from 5 PM until just after 9 PM.

Each tasting pass allows individuals to only visit 20 of the participating locations of your choice. If you enter a location that has a wine you do not prefer, save your hole punch for the next location. Each location will

serve **1 oz.** of wine. For this reason, we ask that you please drink responsibly. We want everyone to have a safe and fun night so we can see you again next year! Taxi service is available in Salisbury, see below.

New to this year's event are "**Snack Stops**". Check your tasting pass for participating restaurants serving a variety of free samples for you to enjoy throughout the night. Simply present your tasting pass to be served. Your tasting pass will not be punched for food samples. This is a free addition to enhance your experience at Wine About Winter.

**HOTEL PACKAGES** – If you booked a hotel package, you must first check in at your hotel prior to coming to Will Call. When you check in to your hotel, you will be provided an envelope including 2 ticket vouchers and a trolley shuttle service schedule. The trolley shuttle will pick you up at your hotel and bring you downtown to the Visitors Center. At the end of the night the trolley will drop you back off at your hotels. The last shuttle will depart the Visitors Center at 9:45 PM. The phone number of the trolley driver will be provided in your envelope.
